

Miss Barbara Young Will Talk on Gibran

Miss Barbara Young, one of the founders of Poetry House in New York City, and friend and secretary of the late mystic poet and painter, Kahlil Gibran, will tell of his life and his work at 8:30 p. m. tomorrow in the Rochester Club ballroom.

Miss Young, whose lecture will be open to the public, will show many of Gibran's original drawings and wood carvings which he used to illustrate his work. Gibran died two years ago in New York City, after some of his works had been translated into 20 languages. "The Prophet" is perhaps the best known of all his works.

Dr. Ewald Eiserhardt, professor of art at the University of Rochester, will preside at the lecture.
